CITY OF PITTSBURGH BICENTENNIAL CELEBRATION – BRIDGE LIGHTING REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION

Q1: I was able to download the RFQ for the Bridge Lighting but couldn't find the application form that is referred to in the RFQ. Please send me the link to this form. Thanks.

Q2: Please clarify exactly which bridges are in the scope of this project, i.e., which bridges should be illuminated?

A2: The 6th and 9th Street bridges have the potential to be illuminated, the 7th Street Bridge will be under reconstruction and cannot be included within the scope of the lighting project. Since the Light Up Night festivities will be focused in and around the 9th Street Bridge with a large celebration in the David L. Lawrence Convention Center as part of the National League of Cities Conference, the 9th Street Bridge should be prioritized.

Q3: The RFQ notes that Duquesne Light has committed to providing 'the power required' for the installation. Does this include providing labor to make the electrical connections, or just supplying the electricity?

A3: Duquesne Light will provide all the labor and materials to provide the electricity for the project. Duquesne Light will work with the selected designer. There will be no cost for the designer to provide electricity for the project.

Q4: The RFQ references a \$200,000 budget, but later notes that funds are being raised. Can you confirm that the full \$200,000 will be available? Is there a chance that the budget will increase?

A4: At this point, we anticipate the full \$200,000 being available and do not expect the budget to increase.
