During the past month, Riverlife has engaged in extensive discussions with the Carnegie Science Center regarding the new signage for its expanded facility. The Science Center has been a very willing and cooperative partner throughout the process, and has responded to a number of suggestions put forth by Riverlife's Riverfront Design Committee.

Riverlife is in favor of allowing the variance requests for size and location of the proposed sign. The proposed sign will replace the existing Science Center sign, but it will be smaller, without animation, and part of the identification for this non-profit, cultural facility of public accommodation. We have had robust discussions on this proposal, and recommend support of the variance requests.
